BEFORE THE RACE

REGISTRATION AND BIB **PICK UP LOCATION**

Customs House, 208 Quay Street Rockhampton Q 4700.

REGISTRATION AND BIB PICK UP TIME

- Saturday 18th May, 9am-4pm
- 2km and 5km runners can collect race packs on Sunday morning 7am - 8:15am at Customs House.
- Please note, no late entries will be accepted on race day.

EVENT START LINE

Quay Street, Rockhampton

TRANSFERS TO ANOTHER DISTANCE

You can transfer to go up or down in distance but you must do this in person at Registration.

Please pick up your bib and then go to the transfer desk. There is no fee, but you must pay the difference in entry fee (at that time) if you go up in distance. There is no refund for going down in distance. Transfers are subject to availability. There are no transfers available to a distance that is SOLD OUT.

TRANSFERS TO **ANOTHER PERSON**

You can transfer to another person however you (or the person you are transferring to) must do this in person at Registration.

It is essential that the person you are transferring to has your bib so please ensure you (or they) pick up your bib and then that person will need to go to the transfer desk.

BAG STORAGE

Bag drop will be available at Customs House, Quay Street, from 5.30am on Sunday morning. Please attach the tear off strip from your race number and attach it to your bag so we can identify your belongings. We do not advise leaving valuables.



AFTER THE RACE

FINISH CHUTE

Once you have completed your event, keep moving through the finish chute to the recovery area. You do not need to hand back your race number.

MEDICAL AID

If you require medical assistance please seek attention from our medical staff at the finish line or on course.

FINISHER MEDAL

All participants will receive their official 7Rocky River Run finisher medal commemorating their completion of the event. After you exit the recovery area you will pass tables for you to take a finisher medal if you would like to. Please only take one medal for your specific distance. Our staff will assist in this.

RECOVERY ZONE

Electrolytes, water, and fresh fruit will be available to participants in recovery.

PRESENTATIONS

EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY

The team from Postrace will be capturing your experience on race day. Remember to smile for the camera and give them a wave. Your personal event photographs will be available for purchase online following the event. Keep an eye on Facebook and Instagram for an update on availability.

The first three male and female finishers across the line in each event will be awarded prizes on the day.
